Our advocacy efforts are full-blown right now! The community health center long term funding legislation expired on September 30th. The House of Representatives passed a Continuing Resolution to fund the government and health extenders through December 11th, but all health centers are still in need of the long term funding to care for our patients.

Oconee Valley Healthcare employees have been signing up as health center advocates and working hard to let Congress know that we care about our patients and our funding! We will be applying to be a Silver Level Advocacy Center of Excellence this year.
